**Notice of Consumer Financial Protection Bureau’s Withdrawal of the Civil
Investigative Demand Issued to J.G. Wentworth**

On June 1, 2017, the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau (Bureau) withdrew the CID issued to J.G. Wentworth, LLC, which is the subject of the Bureau’s Petition to Enforce. (ECF No. 1). Because the CID is no longer active, the Bureau intends to soon dismiss the Petition, either through a stipulation or by seeking a court order under Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41. *See* Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(ii), (a)(2). Therefore, the Bureau respectfully requests that the Court refrain from ruling on the Petition.
