Given the June 19, 2026 Order of the United States Court of Appeals in its case No. 25-5091, remanding the matter for this Court's determination in the first instance of "whether to modify, suspend, or dissolve the preliminary injunction in light of the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau's issuance of a revised reduction-in-force plan and the other intervening developments identified in appellants' motion," it is hereby ORDERED that any documents, declarations, or other materials either party wishes to submit that bear on the question to be decided, which are not already attached to the pleadings submitted to the D.C. Circuit, are due on Thursday, July 2, 2026. Also, in order for the Court to schedule a hearing, the parties must inform the Court by Thursday, June 25 whether they intend to call any witnesses at the hearing and whether counsel are available on any of the following dates: July 17, August 17, 18, or 21, or September 2, 3, 10, or 11. The parties must identify ALL of the dates that work for their side, and they are not being invited to agree to any one date since the state of the Court's calendar is in constant flux. The parties should be aware that the Court is scheduled to begin a complex criminal trial involving 4 defendants and a first degree murder charge on July 6, and that there are other matters complicating its availability in August and early September.
